A competency framework for all prescribers

Our conference chair-person, Hilary Field (from De Montfort University) encouraged all NMPs to familiarise themselves with the framework that has been produced by the Royal Pharmaceutical Society. This was published in 2016 and is essential reading for all prescribers and NMPs.



Standards for Prescribing Programmes
